<p>GETTING STARTED</p>	<p>FOR INDUSTRIAL USE ONLY</p> <p>OAK DRAW 830-A is usually mixed with water for use (add concentrate to water), but may be used undiluted for very heavy duty forming. Use between 5.0% (1:20) and 50.0% (1:1) for most forming of ferrous and nonferrous metals.</p> <p>Add no other substances to the concentrate or mix unless approved by your OAK Representative. Not recommended for use with magnesium or alloyed magnesium.</p>
